• On behalf of the FASNY Officers and Board of Directors have a Happy and safe New Year!

- Applications for all FASNY Awards are up on the website. These applications will not stay on the website
 all year, so if a department has an incident which should be recognized or any submission for the other
 FASNY Awards the applications can be found under the Awards Tab on the FASNY website wit all the
 criteria for each award. All Award submissions must be received by March 15th for the previous year.
- FASNY awards 25 \$1,500 Scholarships to graduating High School Seniors. The applications are on the FASNY website. The deadline for the submission is also March 15th.
- FASNY Help is a grade-based reimbursement program for firefighters young and old attending college. Applicants can be reimbursed up to \$2,000 in tuition at any 2-&4-year colleges. Information on this program is under the Resources tab on the website.
- The Annual EMS Conference will be held at the Selden Fire Department on Saturday, January 28, 2023.
 There wll be a Pre-Conference Workshop on Friday, January 27, 2023 presented by Suffolk County EMS which will be eligible for CORE CME credit hours. The Conference is eligible for Non-Core CME Credit hours.
- The Long Island Metro Show will be held February 3rd-5th, 2023 at the Nassau Coliseum. Along with the Vendors including FASNY there will be training classes presented by the New York State Chiefs. This is also the weekend of the FASNY Winter Games in Cortland, NY.
