The John Maser Scholarship Fund

The Suffolk County Volunteer Firemen's Association created the John Maser Scholarship fund in 2003 to add eternal remembrance of John Maser Sr. John had held many positions with the Volunteer Fire Service within the Medford Fire Department, Medford Fire District, FASNY, Southern New York Volunteer Firemen's Association, Suffolk County Volunteer Firemen's Association to name a few.

This scholarship is based purely on volunteerism within the community and is not based on any scholastic scores.

Guidelines

- Recipients must be the child, grandchild, brother or sister of a member of the Suffolk County Volunteer Firemen's Association and a resident of Suffolk County
- Must be a High School Senior with bonifide proof of acceptance to an accredited Two (2) or Four (4) Year College or University.
- There will be three (3) \$500 Scholarships awarded each year at the July Meeting of the Suffolk County Volunteer Firemen's Association.
- Deadline for Applications is June 1st each year.
- One Scholarship per person.

Application Procedures

- Must have performed Volunteer Community Work. Examples: Junior Fire Fighter, Nursing Home, Hospital, Work with the Disabled, Church, Synagogue or any other Charitable Organization.
- Letter of verification from organization, which Volunteer Work was performed with contact name, and phone number.
- A one page, double space, typed Essay on Volunteerism, must accompany application.
